## Beautiful View: Lake, Mountains and Evergreen Forest

Campground is located on Ashurst Lake with the San Francisco Peaks (mountains) in the background. Campsites are located in a picturesque stand of mature juniper trees and pinyon pines. **Best Sites:** Most sites overlook the lake and have views of the mountain peaks in the distance. **\*\* See notes in the Introduction.**

**Reviews from Other Campers:** 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...Campground is located adjacent to Ashurst Lake with most sites overlooking the lake. It is composed of some Ponderosa pines, but mostly Junipers. There are lots of birds and waterfowl, such as the Blue Heron. The lake is excellent for wind surfing and Sunfish sailing...The parking aprons are irregular, dirt and gravel. In addition, the interior road is badly eroded in places and rough...RVs should fill water tanks before arriving at campground. There is a waste station, available for a fee, at the Pinegrove (National Forest) campground - across from turn to this campground off Lake Mary Rd...Ashurst Lakes is 230 acres. Excellent lake for wind surfing and Sunfish sailing. Power boats are limited to 8hp. The boat ramp is primitive and rocky at its end..."
