### Beautiful View: Mountains and Mature Evergreen Forest

Bog Springs campground is located in Madera Canyon, (a world-class birding area) in a forest of mature Evergreen Oak and Alligator Juniper trees with views of the Santa Rita Mountains. **Best Sites:** Most camp sites have fair to excellent views of the Santa Rita Mountains. This campground is attractively laid out with terraced sites making excellent platforms to set up photographic equipment. **\*\* See notes in the Introduction.**

**Reviews from Other Campers:** 1) We (Camping With A View) visited this campground in late November, 2006. Bog Springs is a beautiful small campground with excellent views of the Santa Rita Mountains. Most of the sites are well spaced with trees and boulders and other vegetation providing separation. Some of the sites are terraced also providing separation. The campground has a rustic feel but is very easy to get to with paved roads almost all the way to the campground. 2) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "**U.S. National Forest Campground Guide**" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground is located in Madera Canyon under mature Evergreen Oak and Alligator Juniper trees. There are excellent views of the Santa Rita Mountains. Bird watching is the main attraction of this primitive campground; over 200 species have been identified. Terraced sites make excellent platforms for the amateur and professional alike to set up their photographic equipment. At the time of our visit, there were no less then four sites set up with some of the most elaborate photographic equipment we have seen...The parking aprons are paved with some being irregular and eroded... "
