Beautiful View: Desert Landscape and Lake

Cholla Recreation Site is located on Theodore Roosevelt Lake, central Arizona's largest lake. The campground is surrounded with desert vegetation and overlooks Roosevelt Lake. **Best Sites:** Per ranger district personnel, all sites have beautiful views of the desert landscape and many sites overlook the lake Roosevelt Lake (because the campground is a distance away from the lake, if the water is low, you won't be able to see the lake. Water levels are dependent on the weather and the need for water in Phoenix.) **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...Campground is largest all-solar powered campground in the United States and is comprised of six loops. Although campground has little overhead vegetation, the picnic tables are shaded by ramadas (roof) and most sites are nicely disbursed and spacious for privacy. Some sites overlook Roosevelt Lake and all tent sites are walk-ins. There are a variety of birds for viewing...The parking aprons are gravel... An RV waste station, with no potable water and no fee, is located about 5 miles north of Roosevelt Dam (across from Cholla campground) on State Rt. 188...Roosevelt Lake is 19, 200 acres..."
