Most walk-in tent sites have a view of the lake. There are two loops. One favors tents (with several wheelchair friendly sites) and the other RVs. Campground is known for bird watching to include Bald Eagles during the winter months. There is a general store near the boat ramp. There are limited groceries, boat rentals and fishing licenses...The parking aprons are paved...Parker Canyon Lake is 160 acres. There is an 8hp motor limit on the lake..."
