Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground is located 8 miles from the Grand Canyon National Park (south rim). It is composed of three loops - Toroweap, Hermit and Moenkopi and has to be one of the best kept secrets for camping near the Grand Canyon. The sites are spacious and widely spaced and will accommodate any size RV. Ponderosa, Pinyon and Juniper pines and Gambel oaks shade the sites. The understory is comprised of a variety of vegetation, including Sage, Skunk Bush, grass, Paintbrush and Lupine...The parking aprons are paved. Some of the pull throughs are very long and will accommodate more than one large RV. Spigots are set back well from the road making them difficult to use for filling water tanks... There is a waste station at the Grand Canyon Camper Village in Tusayan... - no potable water..."
