The tent sites back up on the creek allowing anglers to fish from the comfort of their camp site. The combined camp sites have limited shade and a more desert feel with nice views of surrounding mountain peaks. Bear box food containers are found throughout campground. Firewood is available for a fee. The nearby Cardinal Village Resort offers a variety of services from limited groceries and fishing supplies to internet access, a cafe serving breakfast and lunch, and much more...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are dirt. Camp sites 1 through 3 are on a spur with no turnaround; travel trailers not recommended..."
