Campground is in a mixed pine, hemlock forest located beside Convict Creek and is surrounded by towering mountains. **Best Sites:** Per ranger district personnel, campsites 41, 42, 45, 47, 49, 52, 53, 56, 57, 58 and 59 should have views of Convict Creek. All sites have beautiful views of the John Muir Wilderness area and mountains. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground stretches 0.8 miles along Convict Creek at the north end of Convict Lake. There are towering moraines on three sides of the campground and the sheer barren faces of Mt. Morrison and Laurel Mountain on the fourth. Sagebrush fill the open spaces while Aspen and cottonwood line the creek. Some camp sites enjoy privacy provided by River willow and hedges of wild roses. Although only a few camp sites have a view of the lake, views from every site are vistas of the John Muir Wilderness and mountains...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are paved. Suggest filling up water tanks in RVs at entrance to campground. The pull-throughs are all short.....Convict Lake is 167 acres. Power boats limited to 6hp motors..."
