This tent only campground is located at the north edge of Carson-Iceberg Wilderness area in an alpine forest (Lodgepole and Jeffrey Pine, Red Fir); adjacent to and overlooking Highland Lakes. **Best Sites:** Some sites overlook the lake and/or surrounding wilderness area. Some sites have views of the surrounding mountains and arid landscape. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, at the north edge of Carson-Iceberg Wilderness, overlooks Upper Highland Lake. One section is level with Lake while the second section is above the Lake. This second section is closest to trail leading into Wilderness. Sites in both sections are tucked in among Limber pine and firs but the second section is more heavily wooded. ...Although Upper Highland Lake is the more convenient, Lower Highland Lake, 0.1 mile before campground, is larger. Both lakes are natural and, in the base of a bowl-like area, beautiful. The campground is pack it in, pack it out [whatever you take in you take out - garbage, etc.]...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques.....Upper Highland Lake is 11 acres. Lower Highland Lake is 32 acres. Power boats are limited to 5mph on both lakes..."
