Campground is next to the Scott River in a mixed forest of Fir, Cedar and Ponderosa pine. Although you can see Mt. Shasta from the campground, you can't see it from campsites. **Best Sites:** This campground is situated in a circle around a natural open grassy area. Per campground personnel, about 7 of the sites have views of the river and all have views of the pretty grassy area. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

The campground has no hookups for RVs, and there were none there in the week we stayed: tents only! One site is a walk-in site, so it's really tents only. The location is handy to a bunch of great roads. There's a market 12 miles away in Fort Jones and more retail services 30 miles away in Yreka. It's in that California elevation where live oaks mix with firs and pines, and at 2,500 feet it cools off enough to sleep at night. We thoroughly enjoyed it."
