It stretches along the shore of Letts Lake with several campsites having a view of the lake. The campground and lake are named for the Letts brothers who, in 1855, settled in the area. Twenty years later they were both killed defending their property. This picturesque campground offers good privacy between campsites...The parking aprons are paved... Letts Lake is 35 acres..."
