Beautiful View: Arid Landscape, Rock Formations and Mountains

Campground is located between the Alabama Hills and Mt. Whitney and is on the banks of Lone Pine Creek. The landscape is arid with boulders, sagebrush and other desert vegetation. **Best Sites:** Per ranger district personnel, all sites should have views of the arid landscape; most sites should have views of the rock formations; and many sites have views of Mt. Whitney, the Sierra Mountains or the Alabama Hills. This campground is very popular and fills up. About 60% of the sites are reservable and 40% are first-come-first-serve. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, one of three in the Antelope Lake Recreation Area, is a single loop in a stand of Ponderosa pine on a peninsula. With Antelope Lake on three sides, most camp sites have a view of the water. The lake on the campground's south side is relatively shallow, ideal for supervised wading. The north side of the campground has deeper water so boats can be moored at or near camp sites. It is said the campground is located in the best place for bass fishing. Privacy between camp sites is good. Visit Sunset Point for great sunsets...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques.....The parking aprons are paved...Antelope Lake is 930 acres. Lost Cove boat ramp is 2.8 miles west of campground. Sailing is best in spring..."
