Beautiful View: Arid Landscape and Mountains

Campground is located in a forest of Live Oak and Red Shank trees. The busiest time of the year is typically March through May, before it gets hot. Campground rarely fills up. **Best Sites:** Most all of the sites have a good view of the backside of Palomar Mountain. The low vegetation creates an open feel to the campground, excellent for viewing the night skies, but the shrubbery creates a secluded feel to the individual sites. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground is composed of three loops: Oak, Ribbonwood and Chamise. Attractive campground that is comprised of Chamise, Ribbonwood and Live Oaks in chaparral vegetation. Most sites are open, but secluded because of the Chamise shrubs. There is abundant bird life and clear night skies for star gazing. Some sites have stone fire pits. The nearby Oak Grove features a small museum...The parking aprons are paved. The pull throughs are double-fee sites... Flush toilets are on Chamise and Oak loops; vault toilets only in the Ribbonwood loop..."
