Located on top of a "flat top" mountain, almost every camping site has a breathtaking view of the surrounding mountains, canyons and wildflower-covered meadows. The sites are spacious and widely separated. Some sites are located on a ridge overlooking Deep Lake. While not all the camping sites have a grille, every site has a fire ring. Most Sites are open with small stands of Subalpine fir scattered around the campground. There is no gas for 35 miles...The parking aprons are gravel...Deep Lake is 37 acres. A primitive boat ramp is located in day- use area. Electric motors only..."

From Gypsum, CO, take Interstate 70 west and go about 5 1/2 miles to the Dotsero exit, follow signs for Sweetwater/Burns, turning north on the Colorado River Road. Follow this road 1.8 miles, turning left onto the Coffee Pot Road , FDR 600. Stay on this road for 29 miles, take a right to go up to the campground.
