**Reviews from Other Campers:** 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground is composed of two loops - Lakeside and Forest. It is located in thick woods of Engelmann spruce, Lodgepole pine and Subalpine fir. All pull-through sites are found in the Lakeside Loop and overlook Hahns Peak Lake. This is a very pretty, quiet campground with grass understory and very good privacy between camping sites. Wildflowers, lupine in particular, are abundant throughout the campground...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are dirt...Hahns Peak Lake is 160 acres. Only electric motors are permitted on power boats. The boat ramp is primitive..."
