All sites have view of the lake with some sites located on the shore. The campground is convenient to several resorts, laundromat, mountain trail outfitters and lodges for a cook's night out...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are gravel and dirt...Vallecito Lake is 400 acres. Boat ramps are available at private campgrounds and resorts for a fee. There is also a primitive boat ramp at Graham Creek campground (Forest Service) about 3 miles south of campground..."
