Most camping sites have pleasant view of surrounding mountains or are adjacent to the creek. Access to the campground is through a pretty valley with waterfalls cascading to South Mineral Creek. Firewood is available for a fee. Four-wheel roads lead in all directions from the campground...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are gravel and the interior road is rough..."
