Beautiful View: Lake and Sand Dunes

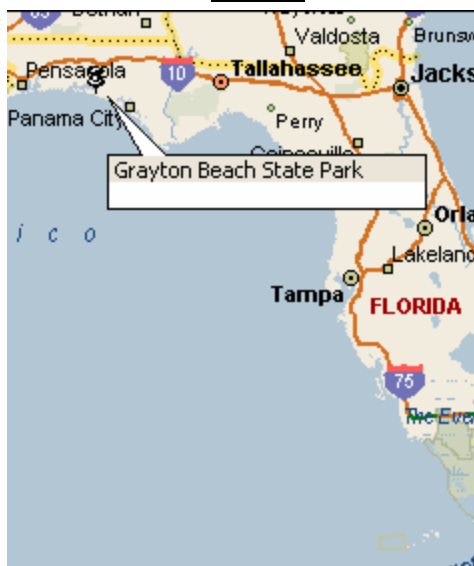

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) We (**Camping With A View**) visited this campground on a day trip in late June 2006. Typical of other Florida State Park campgrounds, most sites are spacious and well separated and the campground is very well designed and maintained. Native flora arranged between camp sites help the separation and make for attractive camp sites. There are about 11 sites that have views of Western Lake. Each of these sites have paths that take you down to the beach. It's unlikely that you will get a camp site at this popular campground without a reservation.

Grayton Beach State Park is located South of U.S. 98 approximately halfway between Panama City Beach and Destin. From Hwy 98, go 3 miles down 283 until you reach the four-way stop. Turn left (east) on County Road 30A and go 1.5 miles. The entrance to Grayton Beach State Park is on your right.
