Beautiful View: Lake and Mixed Forest

This campground is located on the shore of Lake Rathbun with several well separated, waterfront sites in each of the campground's 3 camping areas - Area A, Area B and Area C. **Best Sites:** Area A - Sites A11-A16 all have good to excellent views of the lake. Area B - Sites B3 and B5 have partial views and site B4 has an excellent view. Area C - sites C4-9 have good to excellent views of the lake. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) We (**Camping With A View**) visited this campground on a day trip in late September 2006. This is a U. S. Army Corps of Engineers campground and is laid out very well. Most sites are spacious and well separated and there are several waterfront sites looking onto Lake Rathbun (actually a reservoir) in each of 3 camping areas (A, B, and C).
