Beautiful View: Meadow and Fall Colors

This campground is located near (a 6 minute drive) a major shopping district of Marion, Iowa (a suburb of Cedar Rapids) and has beautiful views of a meadow. This review is of loop B. **Best Sites:** Most of the sites in Loop B have a view of a beautiful prairie/meadow like area and are spacious and fairly private. Fall foliage of surrounding trees also provide a beautiful view. All sites have electrical and water hook up. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Many sites have fair to good separation and excellent views of a prairie/meadow adjacent to the campground. The fall colors of the surrounding deciduous trees is also very pretty. The campground is part of Squaw Creek Park and adjacent of Gardener Golf Course...One drawback to the campground is that it's close to a major highway and a residential area. You can occasionally hear muffled traffic noise from the campground and see the residential area in the distance. Some sites require leveling aides and some are more shaded than others but the park overall has some trees and greenery. Even though the greenery doesn't afford any privacy all sites are angled in such a way that you don't have to look directly at your neighbors. We liked site #1, it was level, more than large enough for our 30 ft class A and had no neighbor on one side. Park was quiet even over the weekend that we were there...."
