Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The sites on the north shore (1-8) are recommended for tents and small RVs. These camp sites are tucked into a pleasant mixture of shady Douglas firs, Lodgepole pines, and other conifers on the shore of the lake. The sites on the west shore of the lake (9-15) are also nestled in the cool shade of firs, pines, and other conifers and are recommended for tents only. ... [sites] (16-32) is the newest part of the campground and touches the smaller Martin Lake. Lodgepole pines dominate this single loop and although none of the camp sites are adjacent to Martin Lake, some have a view of the lake. ...Privacy varies from fair to very good throughout the campground...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are gravel in the newest and horse sections and dirt and irregular in the other sections...The water spigots are hand pumps..."
