Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...This campground is one of 37 in the Sawtooth National Recreation Area (SNRA). It is a scenic campground located on the northwest side of the Sawtooth Wilderness far from noisy crowds. An older campground with lots of grand Ponderosa pine, Lodgepole pine and Douglas fir, it is configured as one large loop with the Grandjean Trail at one end of the circle. Camp sites 1 through 23 are for campers without horses (livestock) and camp sites 24 through 31 are designed for campers with livestock. ... Not a particularly RV friendly campground, it does have some great tent-only sites. A few camp sites overlook the Payette River and a couple others are alongside an unnamed creek...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are irregular, dirt, rocky, and rough..."
