Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, divided into two family sections which are separated by a small bridge, stretches out along a shore of the Warm River... The first section has older, larger trees, which are Weeping willows, gravel aprons, and a gentle sloping bank. The second section, located above the river, has little shade, paved aprons, and tables and grilles anchored in cement. The campground's appearance is manicured with nicely trimmed lawns and trees. The Warm River is a gentle flowing river providing excellent float or tubing activities for the whole family... All the tent sites are walk-ins. ...Most of the camping sites are either adjacent to or overlook the river. ...This is bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...There are paved and gravel parking aprons... The Warm River is 52 degrees year-round and is a nice family floating river..."
