Along the spur are four camp sites, and at its end, are several more. As with sites in the loop, many along the spur overlook the lake, but in addition, they are secluded and very pleasant to park an RV or pitch a tent. Generally, the campground is covered with groomed grass and is a delightful place to enjoy fishing, boating, or just "kicking back." Boats can be moored close to or at some camp sites. ...The parking aprons and interior roads are gravel.....Lake Barkley is 59,900 acres..."
