### Beautiful View: Lake and Mixed Forest

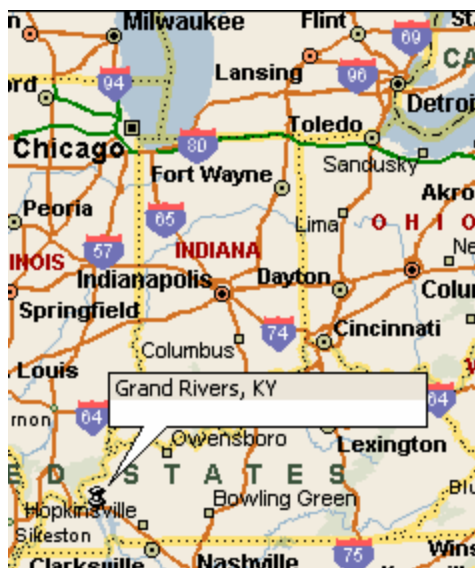

Parking aprons are gravel. Interior road is paved. Continue to LBL Visitor Center.Follow the Trace North approximately 18 miles and see the sign for Hillman Ferry. Make a left turn and follow the road to the gatehouse.
