Stretching out along the shores of Lake Barkley, the campground offers good fishing and sites with nice views of the lake. The campground also has a couple of sites at a primitive boat ramp. Possible day trips are the North and South Welcome Stations, Golden Pond Visitor Center, the Planetarium, Elk and Bison Prairie, Woodlands Nature Station, and The Homeplace...The parking aprons are dirt. All parking aprons are about same size...The nearest drinking water is located at North Welcome Station...Lake Barkley is 59,700 acres..."
