Beautiful View: River (salt water), Fall Colors

Chewonki Campground is a small, quiet campground with only 47 sites on 50 acres located on the coast of Maine and overlooks a salt water river or inlet of Montsweag Bay on the Atlantic Ocean. Sites tend to be large, grassy and attractively laid out. **Best Sites:** Full hookup sites are on a sloping grassy hillside with views of the inlet. Sites 10A-C, 12-16, 26 and RB are water front sites. The surrounding trees provide beautiful views of Fall Colors for all sites during peak foliage. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Directions

Chewonki Campground is located in Wiscasset, Maine. Northbound - Maine Turnpike 95 to Exit 52 - Take Route 295 to Exit 28 - Continue on Route 1 to Bath - 7 miles to Route 144 - turn right. Follow directional signs for 1.5 miles. Southbound - Take Route 95 to first Augusta exit. Take Route 27 to Wiscasset, take Route 1 south 4 miles and follow signs, or follow scenic Route 1 along coast.
