Beautiful View: Lake and Mixed Forest

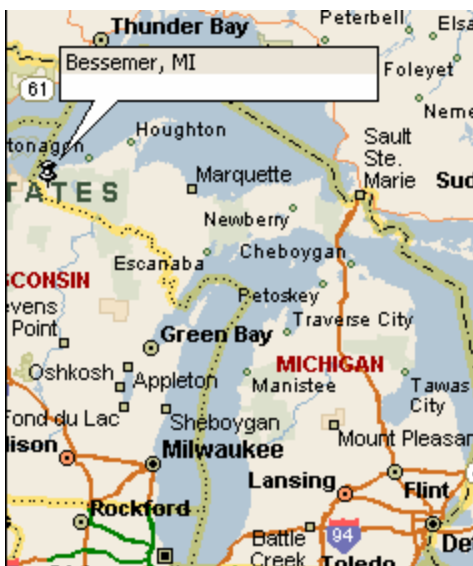

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...This single loop campground is located on a bluff above Lake Superior and near Black River Harbor. The camp sites are nestled in a pleasant mixture of hardwoods. There are facilities for the "transient" boat as well as gasoline, boat pumpout service and private charter boat services. The campground has a scenic overlook of Lake Superior Apostle Islands, along with flush toilets, RV waste station, and several hiking trails to the 5 nearby scenic waterfall of the Black River. Some of these trails are wheelchair friendly. An unusual site is the Copper Peak Ski-Flying Hill, a short driving distance from the campground. It is a ski jump that is built of steel and stands 17 stories high. The longest recorded jump is 505 feet. One can take an elevator up to view the surrounding area...Parking aprons are gravel..."
