Beautiful View: River, Meadow and Deciduous (Fall Colors) Forest

Campground is along the banks of the Huzzah River with some sites overlooking a large grassy meadow-like area and others overlooking the Huzzah river. **Best Sites:** Many sites in this campground are just a few steps away from the clear pristine Huzzah River. The river is small but large enough for canoeing, tubing and rafting. None of the many sites along the river have hook-up but most all can accommodate RVs. Sites A-M, 56, 15-17, 61-63, and 70-85 should have good views of the river. **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) We (**Camping With A View**) visited this resort on a day trip in late May 2006 at the start of their peak season. The resort is in a very beautiful, rural area within a few miles of the Bass River Resort. This campground is also very well maintained and well manicured with many sites overlooking the Huzzah River or a very pretty meadow. Many of the sites with the best views were fairly spacious and well separated. The river is clear and pristine. None of the sites with waterfront views have hook-up due to the possibility of flooding during certain times of the year; but most of these sites will accommodate an RV...This is more than a campground, it's a resort with a pool, store, restaurant, horseback riding, floating equipment rental, etc. All in spacious and well manicured grounds in a beautiful, rural area of the Ozark River Region.
