### Beautiful View: River, and Deciduous (Fall Colors) Forest

This resort is located on an Ozark Mountain along the banks of the North Fork of the White River. **Best Sites:** The main feature of this resort is their 7 "tree house" cabins, high off the ground with beautiful views of the river and forest across the river bank. RV sites 4 and 8 have good views of the river with good separation. There are some less secluded sites next to the river as well. **Reviews from Other Campers:** 1) We (**Camping With A View**) visited this resort on a day trip in early August, 2006. The resort is in a remote part of the Ozark Mountains along the North Fork of the White River on 275 acres of private land. It's located in the heart of the Wild Trout Management Area with over a mile of private wade fishing. One of the main features of the resort is the "tree house" cabins - but they also have 8 camp sites. Camp site number 8 (with RV hook-up) is secluded, close to the river and has excellent views. Site # 4 also is an RV site with excellent views and fairly good separation. Tent campers should also be able to find sites with excellent views. Reservations are highly recommended since there are so few camp sites. 2) And here is an excerpt from **RV Parks Review** web site <http://rvparkreviews.com/regions/Missouri/Dora.html#CGID5026>: "...My idea of a good campsite is quiet, scenic, and uncrowded and this place has it. From Dora, MO, Travel south on Hwy. 181 7 miles to Crossroads Store driveway (County Rd 372). Continue on 372 for 0.7 miles to County Rd 365. Turn right onto County Rd 365. Continue south 2.1 milesto the River of Life Farm entrance on left. Continue approx. 1.5 miles to bottom of hill and turn left and proceed 0.3 miles to ROLF office for check in.
