**Reviews from Other Campers:** 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, adjacent to Clear Spring Lake, consists of two loops. One is along a ridge above the lake and the other is at lakeside. Most camp sites offer a delightful view and some are terraced. The pavilion located in the day-use area is the only indication left of its Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) origin. In general, the campground is beautifully manicured, picturesque and reflects "loving" care. One unusual feature is a bicycle shower located at the trailhead of Tally's Trail. If horseback riding is of interest, there is the nearby, privately-owned Brushy Creek Guest Ranch. Horses can be rented for trail riding through some beautiful Homochitto National Forest hills and countryside...Parking aprons are paved...Clear Springs Lake is 10 acres. There is a large, beautifully manicured grass and sandy beach..."
