Directions

From I-240 in Asheville, take exit 4. Stay on 19-23 North for approximately 6 miles. Get off at the New Stock Rd. exit. At the end of the ramp, you will be at a traffic light. Turn right and you will immediately be at a second traffic light. Turn right ag (Note: If you are going south on Hwy 19-23 (towards Asheville), turn left at the bottom of the New Stock Rd. exit ramp, go through the first traffic light, and turn right at the second traffic light.) Go 7 tenths of a mile to the first road on the right
