Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, located near Spring Creek and comprised of two loops, is most unique. The lower loop has a park-like feel, while the upper loop with its many close-growing trees, has more of a wilderness feel. Landscaping for the lower loop is very attractive with manicured grass understory and sculptured miniature hemlock trees. These trees seem to grow no more than 20 feet in height and are clumped at the top like palm trees. Most of the sites in the campground are terraced and built with stone walls. The predominant deciduous trees are maple, oak, and Dogwood. A cemetery is accessed via site 29 and is a reminder of the former residents - the Robert Brooks family.Some parking aprons are paved, others are gravel. Low-hanging branches could be a problem for high-profile RVs. A few parking aprons have a significant slope..."
