Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...Under Ponderosa and other conifer trees, the campground is a single loop with one side adjacent to Rio Las Vacas (river). The understory is grass and pine needles. The San Pedro Park Wilderness is 5 miles away with a 37-mile network of trails. Some sites overlook the river and others overlook a park-like meadow...The parking aprons are paved. The interior road is a tear-drop shape making it difficult for RVs to make a second pass...Wading is possible in the Rio Las Vacas..."
