The first loop has shorter parking aprons and more shade than the second, lower loop. The campground is convenient to Wells, NV for a cook's night out. Not as high as the nearby Angel Lake campground, vistas of Clove Valley are limited, but views of the northern stretch of Ruby Mountains, are magnificent...The parking aprons are paved..."
