Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...There are two loops - North and South. The campground is located in the dunes and has a heavy understory of Rhododendrons, Salal and other shrubs. Some sites are very secluded by these trimmed shrubs which have the appearance of hedges. There are also Shore pines, many of which are covered with Lichen. Access to the Pacific Ocean beach is possible via the Umpqua Dunes Interpretive Trail. OHV riding in the campground is not permitted. The campground is one of 10 campgrounds in the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area...The parking aprons are paved..."
