### Beautiful View: Lake and Mature Evergreen Forest

Lake in the Woods is a 4 acre man-made lake (8' at its deepest point) with nearby hiking trails to scenic waterfalls. The area is alive with color in the spring with rhododendrons and many wildflowers. **Best Sites:** Most campsites have views of the lake. **\*\* See notes in the Introduction.**

The lake began as a marsh until it was made into the lake in 1954. By the end of summer, this swampy past can be seen in the lake's algae-covered still water. In the Spring a wreath of rhododendron and wildflowers bring beautiful color to the lake and campground. Privacy between campsites is good. Mature Douglas fir surround the lake...The parking aprons are dirt. Grey water disposal sites are scattered around campground...Lake in the Woods is 4 acres..."
