From I95: Take exit #193, travel south on SC HWY 9 for approximately 54 miles. Turn left on SC HWY 905 for 1.8 miles. Turn left onto Old Buck Creek Rd. for 1.4 miles then turn right into WillowTree. From Myrtle Beach: Take 501 west to HWY 31N. Travel north until Hwy 31 ends. Exit left ramp onto Hwy 9 North toward Loris. Turn right onto SC 905, travel 1.8 miles. Turn left onto Old Buck Creek Rd for 1.4 miles then turn right into WillowTree.
