Beautiful View: Meadows and Mixed Forest

Campground sits just off the Nebo Loop, a National Scenic Byway. The dominant vegetation consists of fir trees, aspen, open grass meadows and gamble oak. **Best Sites:** Per ranger district personnel, most sites have views of beautiful meadows. Although the campground is in the mountains, you can't see the mountains from most camp sites.

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground, pack it in, pack it out [what you take in, you take out - garbage, etc.], is composed of five loops - A, B, C, D, and E. Although loops A through D are designed for groups, camp sites within them are available for single families if not reserved. Loop E is the only loop with single family sites and is also available to campers with horses. There is a loading ramp and hitching rails available in this loop. (Horses are not permitted in Loops A through D.) Camp sites in Loop E are mostly on the outside where some shade is provided by fir and Aspen trees. Loops C and D are the smallest with only two camp sites provided in each. Loops A through D have limited shade. Large meadows and spectacular views give this campground its distinctive character. Fire wood is available for a fee...The parking aprons are paved..."

In Payson, UT, From I-15, take exit 250 (North Payson/Salem) and proceed south on Main Street to 100 North / Hwy 198. Travel east to 600 East. Turn south onto 600 East (Peeteetneet Academy is on the corner). Travel south. 600 East becomes Nebo Scenic Loop/ Payson Canyon Road. Travel up the canyon to the campground.
