Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...Campground is located along the fast-flowing Sol Duc River with some sites overlooking the river. Vegetation is rain-forest lush throughout. It is conveniently located for day trips to Sol Duc Hot Springs (Olympic National Park), Neah Bay with its boardwalk trail and coastal observation platform, Makah Tribe's Cultural Museum and the Timber Museum in Forks, WA... Walking along the Pioneer's Path located in the campground is a must. It rivals the Hoh Rain Forest trails in the Olympic National Park. Average rainfall per year (on the western side of the Olympic National Forest) is about 120 inches - usually the heaviest during October through June. There is an amphitheatre with interpretive programs on the weekends during the summer months...The parking aprons are gravel. Larger parking aprons are found at sites 49 through 55..."
