The understory is grass and privacy between sites is fair. Be sure to take a short walk to a dramatic waterfall which can be heard throughout the campground. This scenic campground is convenient for day drives up to Beartooth Pass, Clay Butte Fire Tower (for some great vistas) and the Yellowstone National Park. The drive along the Chief Joseph Scenic Byway is gorgeous with many vistas. Parts of it trace the flight or retreat of the Nez Perce Indians...This is grizzly bear country; practice safe food storage techniques...The parking aprons are gravel..."

From Cody, WY, take state route 120 west about 16 miles to Rt. 296 (Chief Joseph Scenic Byway); turn left on 296 and go about 46 1/2 miles to US Rt. 212 (Beartooth Scenic Byway). Turn left onto Rt. 212 and go about 2 1/2 miles and follow signs to campground.
