Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...The campground is a single loop in a thick stand of Lodgepole pine with a few spruce scattered throughout. Most of the camping sites have vistas of the surrounding mountains, such as Norton Point. The campground is located where Frontier Creek and Wiggins Fork join just outside the Washakie Wilderness. Although a long and sometimes rough drive, this campground offers good fishing, hiking and wildlife viewing in a spectacularly scenic area...This is grizzly bear country; practice safe food storage techniques. There are bear-proof food containers at some sites...The parking aprons are grass and dirt..."

In Dubois, WY, at the intersection of US Rt. 26W/287N and Horse Creek Rd. , take Horse Creek Rd. north 10 miles to a "T" intersection. Turn right at the intersection and go 2 miles to another intersection. Bear right, staying on Forest Rt. 285, and go about 13 miles to campground.
