Beautiful View: Mountains and Evergreen Forest

Campground has only one rental unit with spectacular views of the surrounding area. Formerly used to detect fires, the live-in tower rises 55 feet above a forested mountaintop in the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests. **Best Sites:** The look out tower is the only unit in the "campground". It comes equipped with 2 single beds, a refrigerator, stove, heater and lamps (all fueled by propane). **** See notes in the Introduction.**

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) The following excerpts are from a campground description found in the "U.S. National Forest Campground Guide" web site (<http://www.forestcamping.com/index.htm>) : "...Live a little bit of history and enjoy an incredible view in southeastern Wyoming with an overnight stay at the Spruce Mountain Fire Lookout Tower. Formerly used to detect fires, the live-in tower rises 55 feet above a forested mountaintop in the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests. ...The tower is at an elevation of 10,003 feet and visitors should be prepared for high altitude conditions. Summertime temperatures average 70 degrees but can drop as low as 30 degrees at night or during thunderstorms..."

The Spruce Mountain Fire Lookout Tower may be rented from mid-June to October 1st, weather permitting. There is maximum reservation of 2 consecutive nights, no more than 10 nights per calendar year, and no more than 3 weekends per calendar year....Additional camping is allowed on the site, with a total of 10 occupants at the site....Saddle and pack stock are allowed at the site but must be kept 500 feet from the tower's base...."
