The following sites all have good to excellent views of the beautiful Lake of the Ozarks: 116-118, 104-106, 126-128, 137, 140-141 and 158-169. Sites 121-159 have electric hook-up. **Notes:** A double asterix "*" means that there are notes found in the introduction to Camping With A View Campground Directory that pertain to this campground.

Reviews from Other Campers: 1) We (**Camping With a View**) visited this campground on a day trip in late May 2006. The campground is laid out very well. Most sites are spacious and well separated and there are many waterfront sites on the beautiful Lake of the Ozarks. Most of the sites by the lake are nicely terraced so that even many of the sites that are a few rows back from the shore still have fair to good views of the lake.
